

**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 2001 ASSEMBLY BILL 852**

March 5, 2002 – Offered by Representative WALKER.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 7: delete “witnessing” and substitute “hearing or observing”.

3 **2.** Page 3, line 16: delete the material beginning with that line and ending on  
4 page 4, line 7, and substitute:

5 “**SECTION 5m.** 949.01 (6) of the statutes is amended to read:

6 949.01 **(6)** “Victim” means a person who is injured or killed by an incident  
7 specified in s. 949.03 (1) (a), ~~or~~ by any act or omission of any other person that is  
8 within the description of any of the offenses listed in s. 949.03 (1) (b) or within the  
9 description of the offense listed and the condition provided in s. 949.03 (1) (c), or as  
10 a result of a crime described in s. 949.03 (1) (d). This definition does not apply to s.  
11 949.165.”.
