## DRAFTER'S NOTE FROM THE LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE BUREAU

February 22, 2002

**Representative Krug:** 

The attached draft permits the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors to increase or decrease its size during the time period between the adoption of decennial redistricting plans. The draft is modeled after similar provisions in the laws relating to cities. However, the draft also incorporates standards relating to redistricting that apply to counties generally. Under the draft, if the board adopts a revised districting plan before November 15 preceding a spring election, it is effective at that election. Otherwise, it is effective at the following supervisory election. Under the draft, the first election at which changes could be implemented will be the 2004 spring election.

Please let us know if we have misunderstood your intent or if you desire any changes.
