

**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 3,
TO 2001 ASSEMBLY BILL 872**

March 7, 2002 – Offered by Representative CARPENTER.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 5: delete “(a). In that case,” and substitute “(a), provided the
3 decrease is approved at a referendum, as described in s. 59.52 (25), held under subd.
4 3. If the board decreases the number of supervisors,”.

5 **2.** Page 3, line 4: after that line insert:

6 “3. ‘Referendum.’ The board may adopt a resolution calling for a referendum,
7 to be held not earlier than 42 days after the adoption of the resolution, on whether
8 the board may reduce its size under subd. 1. The referendum question shall be
9 substantially as follows: “May the board of supervisors of ... County reduce its size
10 before the board redistricts itself following the [year of next federal decennial
11 census] federal census?” If a majority of the electors who vote in the referendum vote
12 “Yes,” the board may reduce its size under subd. 1.”.
