6 **146.96 Uniform claim processing form.** Beginning no later than July 1, 2004, every  
7 health care provider, as defined in s. 146.81 (1), shall use the uniform claim processing form  
8 developed by the commissioner of insurance under s. 601.41 (9) (b) when submitting a claim  
9 to an insurer."

16 4. "Small employer insurer" has the meaning given in s. 635.02 (8).

17 (b) If the federal government has not developed by July 1, 2003, a uniform claim  
18 processing form that must be used by all health care providers for submitting claims to insurers  
19 and by all insurers for processing claims submitted by health care providers, the commissioner

1 shall develop, by no later than December 31, 2003, a uniform claim processing form for that  
2 purpose.

3 **SECTION 17p.** 610.65 of the statutes is created to read:

4 **610.65 Uniform claim processing form.** Beginning no later than July 1, 2004, every  
5 insurer shall use the uniform claim processing form developed by the commissioner under s.  
6 601.41 (9) (b) when processing a claim submitted by a health care provider, as defined in s.  
7 146.81 (1).”.
