**Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau**

\* Under current law, no political subdivision (city, village, town, or county), other than a 1st class city (currently only Milwaukee) or a county with a population of 500,000 or more (currently only Milwaukee County), may prohibit a law enforcement officer who is employed by a political subdivision from being a candidate for elective public office, if he or she is otherwise qualified to be a candidate. Also under current law, no law enforcement officer may be required, as a condition of being a candidate for any elective public office, to take a leave of absence during his or her candidacy.

Under this bill, no political subdivision, other than a 1st class city or a county with a population of 500,000 or more, may prohibit any other employee of a political subdivision from being a candidate for elective public office, if he or she is otherwise qualified to be a candidate. Also under the bill, no employee of a political subdivision may be required, as a condition of being a candidate for any elective public office, to take a leave of absence during his or her candidacy.

Also under current law, no law enforcement officer may be required, as a condition of being a candidate for any elective public office, to take a leave of absence during his or her candidacy. Under this bill, no political subdivision, <sup>including</sup> other than a 1st class city, <sup>and</sup> a county with a population of 500,000 or more, may prohibit any other employee of a political subdivision from being a candidate for elective public office, if he or she is otherwise qualified to be a candidate. Also under the bill, no employee of a political subdivision may be required, as a condition of being a candidate for any elective public office, to take a leave of absence during his or her candidacy.
