

**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 3,  
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 2001 ASSEMBLY BILL 889**

March 5, 2002 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON INFORMATION POLICY AND TECHNOLOGY.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 3: after “rates;” insert “prohibiting persons who provide  
3 broadcast and cable television services from transmitting programming that is  
4 encrypted in a certain manner;”.

5 **2.** Page 5, line 2: after that line insert:

6 “**SECTION 10m.** 100.2065 of the statutes is created to read:

7 **100.2065 Encryption of audio and video programming prohibited. (1)**

8 In this section:

9 (a) “Broadcast service” has the meaning given in s. 196.01 (1m).

10 (b) “Cable television service” has the meaning given s. 196.01 (1p).

11 **(2)** No person who provides a broadcast service or a cable television service may  
12 transmit from this state programming that is encrypted in such a manner that the

1 programming may not be recorded by a recipient of the programming for the  
2 recipient's personal use, unless the personal use is prohibited under federal law.”.
