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


TO 2001 SENATE BILL 55**

June 29, 2001 - Offered by Representative KRUSICK.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 1. Page 559, line 14: after that line insert:

3 ~~SECTION 1483j.~~ 46.03 (44)^x of the statutes is created to read:

4 46.03 (44) PHARMACY OUTREACH PROGRAM. (a) In this subsection[✓] (30 4)

5 1. "Low-income" means having an annual household income that does not
6 exceed 185% of the poverty line for a family the size of the resident's eligible family.

7 2. "Poverty line" means the nonfarm federal poverty line for the continental
8 United States, as defined by the federal department of labor under 42-~~USC~~ 9902 (2).

9 ~~By~~ "Prescription drug" has the meaning given in s. 450.01 (20).[✓]

10 (b) Within the limits of available funding, the department shall implement, ~~on~~
~~on~~ pilot basis in one administrative region of the state, as determined by the

12 ~~department,~~ a pharmacy outreach program to develop systems to facilitate access to

1 pharmaceutical manufacturer patient assistance programs. The department may
2 contract with one or more public or private organizations to administer the program.

3 (c) A program established under par. (b) [✓] may do any of the following:

4 1. Provide consultation with health care providers about the program.

5 2. Provide patients with information about their eligibility for pharmaceutical
6 manufacturer patient assistance programs.

7 3. Assist health care providers in enrolling their patients in a pharmaceutical
8 manufacturer patient assistance program under subd. 2.

9 4. Provide health care providers with opportunities to work with
10 representatives of pharmaceutical manufacturers to improve pharmaceutical
11 manufacturer patient assistance programs under subd. 2.

12 (d) The department may negotiate with pharmaceutical manufacturers to
13 develop a simplified system to assist ~~low-income~~ ^{low-income} residents of this state in obtaining
14 access to pharmaceutical manufacturer patient assistance programs. The system
15 may include a simplified, single application process and a voucher system for
16 dispensing prescription drugs through local pharmacies.

17 (e) Before March 1 annually, the department shall submit a report to the chief
18 clerk of each house of the legislature for distribution to the appropriate standing
19 committees under s. 13.172 (3), and to the governor, on the number of residents of
20 this state who have benefited ~~by~~ ^{from} [✓] pharmaceutical manufacturer patient assistance
21 programs in the previous calendar year, the value of benefits provided by those
22 programs, and other information about those programs that the department
23 determines is relevant. In preparing the report, the department shall consult with

1 pharmaceutical manufacturers, pharmacists, and consumers of prescription drugs,

This bill creates, in the department of health and family services (DHFS), a ~~pharmacy~~ pharmacy outreach program ~~in one administrative region of Wisconsin,~~ to provide patients with information about their eligibility for pharmaceutical manufacturer patient assistance programs, assist health care providers in enrolling their patients in these programs, provide health care providers with opportunities to work with pharmaceutical manufacturer representatives to improve the programs, and provide consultation with health care providers about the pharmacy outreach program. DHFS may, under the bill, negotiate with pharmaceutical manufacturers to develop a simplified system to assist state residents in obtaining ~~access~~ ^{access} assistance to the pharmaceutical manufacturer patient assistance programs. Before March 1 of each year, DHFS must submit a report to the legislature and to the governor on the number of state residents who have benefited from pharmaceutical manufacturer patient assistance programs, the value of benefits provided by the programs, and other information that DHFS determines is relevant.
