Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Signs to mark routes would be placed every 30 to 40 miles and typically after a larger community.

Sign installations would average about \$500 each, including the sign, posts, labor and equipment. Certain overhead costs for planning, scheduling, and administering the work to accomplish this project are not included in the estimate and would be absorbed.

Total project would involve installation of 52 signs.

Sign life is projected to be ten years, creating an annualized impact of 10% of the capital costs.
