Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This joint resolution provides that a committee of conference shall be a "closed conference" by limiting the authority of a committee of conference to reconciling the differences in the positions of the senate, assembly and joint committee on finance. However, a committee of conference is permitted to consider any other issue that the governor finds to be an emergency issue if either the presiding officers of both houses or both chairpersons of the joint committee on finance concur in the finding.

Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That:

SECTION 1. Joint rule 3 is renumbered joint rule 3 (1).

SECTION 2. Joint rule 3 (2) is created to read:

Joint Rule 3 (2) (a) Except as provided in par. 
