5 (5) Any member may, at any time that a bill is before the senate or assembly, 6 raise the issue that the bill requires a local fiscal estimate prepared under this rule, 7 and if the presiding officer determines that the bill, not having the estimate, requires 8 an estimate, the presiding officer shall direct the legislative fiscal bureau to prepare 9 the requisite estimate.

10 (6) Local fiscal estimates prepared under this rule are required on original bills
11 only and not on substitute amendments or amendments.".
