3 biennial session schedule shall provide for a 3-day veto review session in November
4 or December of the odd-numbered year. The veto review session shall be a floor period
5 limited to action on gubernatorial vetoes or partial vetoes.

6 (2) (a) Any vetoes of regular or special session bills not previously on a calendar
7 in the house of origin shall be shown as pending business on the calendar for the veto
8 review session's first day.

9 (b) Any veto required to be scheduled under par. (a) that does not receive final
10 action during the veto review session is sustained. The disposition shall be recorded
11 as "failed to pass notwithstanding the objections of the governor."

12 (3) Any veto received from the other house for concurrence notwithstanding the
13 objections of the governor may be taken up immediately.
