

2001 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 16

January 25, 2001 – Introduced by COMMITTEE ON RULES. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1 **To create** joint rule 28; **relating to:** when conferences of members of committees of
2 conference are open to the public.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Joint Rule 28: This joint resolution prohibits the cochairpersons of every committee of conference from conferring together in private and permits less than one-half of the members of every committee of conference to confer together at the same time in private.

Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That:

4 **SECTION 1.** Joint rule 28 is created to read:

5 JOINT RULE 28. **When conferences of members of committees of**
6 **conference are open to the public.** (1) Except as otherwise provided in sub. (2),
7 a member of a committee of conference may confer together with one or more other
8 members of the committee at the same time, for a conference that is not open to the
9 public, if all of those conferring together at that time make up less than one-half of
10 the members of the committee.
