3 Whereas, there are 16 community action agencies in Wisconsin working and
4 collaborating with local communities to alleviate the circumstances of poverty and
5 helping people achieve self-sufficiency; and

6 Whereas, the community action agencies have, for 35 years, developed
7 innovative pilot and major programming in the areas of affordable housing and
8 homeownership, weatherization and rehabilitation of homes, employment and
9 microenterprise business development, Head Start, food and nutrition,
10 community-based economic development, transportation, training and on-site
11 technical assistance to rural communities with water or wastewater problems,
12 health, and education, and many other such helping programs; and
