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



1 **Relating to:** creating a committee of conference on electoral reform.

2 *Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That*, upon the adoption
3 of this joint resolution by the assembly and concurrence therein by the senate and
4 notwithstanding joint rule 3, there is created a committee of conference on electoral
5 reform, to reconcile the differences between the 2[✓] houses, as reflected by 2001
6 Assembly Bill 49[✓], as engrossed by the assembly, 2001 Senate Bill 110[✓], as engrossed
7 by the senate, and 2001 Senate Bill 110[✓], as affected by assembly amendments 2 to
8 8 thereto, and to present its report on either or both of the bills to the 2 houses; and,
9 be it further

10 *Resolved, That*, notwithstanding joint rule 3, senate rule 35[✓], and assembly
11 rule 40 (1):

12 (1) Neither bill need receive 3 readings.

13 (2) The committee of conference shall consist of 4 members from each house

14 ~~with 3 members from each house representing the majority party in that house and~~

15 ~~one member from each house nominated by the minority leader in that house.~~

1 (3) The members of the committee of conference shall be appointed by the
2 speaker of the assembly in the case of assembly members and be appointed by the
3 president of the senate in the case of senate members.

11 rule 40 (1):

12 (1) Neither bill need receive 3 readings.

13 (2) The committee of conference shall consist of 4 members from each house.

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1 (3) The report by the committee of conference must be supported by the vote
2 of at least a majority of the members representing each house.

1 offenses related to driving while under the influence of an intoxicant; the prohibited
 2 alcohol concentration related to operating a motor vehicle while under the influence
 3 of an intoxicant; creating a safe-ride grant program; certain alcohol beverage
 4 offenses committed by persons under the legal drinking age; making an
 5 appropriation; and providing penalties, to reconcile the differences between the 2
 6 houses, as reflected by 1999 Senate Bill 125 as engrossed by the senate and 1999
 7 Assembly Bill 221 as engrossed by the assembly, and to present its report on the bill
 8 to the 2 houses; and

9 ***Be it further resolved, That,*** notwithstanding joint rule 3 (intro.) and (1),
 10 senate rules 4 (9) and 35 and assembly rule 40:

11 (1) Neither bill need receive 3 readings.

12 (2) The committee of conference on 1999 Senate Bill 125 shall consist of 4
 13 members from each house, with 3 members from each house representing the
 14 majority party in that house and one member from each house nominated by the
 15 minority leader in that house

16 (3) The members of the committee of conference on 1999 Senate Bill 125 shall
 17 be appointed by the speaker of the assembly in the case of assembly members and
 18 be appointed by the president of the senate, without approval of the senate, in the
 19 case of senate members.

20 (4) The report by the committee of conference on 1999 Senate Bill 125 must be
 21 supported by the votes of at least a majority of the members representing each house.
