

2001 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 55

June 29, 2001 – Introduced by Representative FOTI.

1 **Relating to:** creating a committee of conference on 2001 Senate Bill 55, the
2 executive budget bill of the 2001 legislature.

3 ***Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That,*** upon the adoption
4 of this joint resolution by the assembly and concurrence therein by the senate and
5 notwithstanding joint rule 3, there is created a committee of conference on 2001
6 Senate Bill 55, relating to state finances and appropriations, constituting the
7 executive budget bill of the 2001 legislature, to reconcile the differences between the
8 2 houses, and to present its report on the bill to the 2 houses; and, be it further

9 ***Resolved, That,*** notwithstanding joint rule 3 (intro.), the committee of
10 conference shall consist of 3 members of the majority party and one member of the
11 minority party from each house; and, be it further

12 ***Resolved, That:***

13 (1) The committee of conference shall be a “closed conference,” with the
14 authority of the members of the committee limited to reconciling the differences in

1 the positions of the 2 houses as reflected by the proposal as engrossed by the first
2 house, and the proposal, as concurred in and amended by the 2nd house.

3 (2) Neither house may consider a report if it contains an agreement that
4 recommends the approval of and concurrence in any issue not authorized under sub.
5 (1).
