This joint resolution requests the legislative council to conduct a study of terrorism and methods to counter acts of terrorism. The council is requested to report its findings, conclusions, and recommendations to the 2003 legislature when it convenes.

6 2003 legislature when it convenes in the manner provided under section 13.172 (2)  
7 of the statutes.
