1 **Relating to:** the life and public service of Ervin Butch Conradt.

2 Whereas, Ervin "Butch" Conradt was born on October 4, 1916, in the ~~Town~~ of  
3 Bovina, Wisconsin, and died on November 5, 2001, in Appleton, Wisconsin; and

4 Whereas, he was educated at Springbrook Elementary School; and

5 Whereas, Mr. Conradt, who was known by everyone as "Butch" began farming  
6 in 1940 and was a lifetime farmer; and

7 Whereas, he married Grace Voight, who preceded him in death on January 29,  
8 1973; and

9 Whereas, after years of being a widower, Butch married Lillian (Kuhn)  
10 McDougal on April 20, 1985; and

11 Whereas, he received his first taste as an elected official with a stint on the  
12 Bovina town board as board supervisor (1951<sup>from</sup> to 1952<sup>to</sup>) and as board chairman

13 1953<sup>to</sup> 1967 and 1979<sup>to</sup> 1990, and he served on the Outagamie County board 1953<sup>from</sup> to 1973<sup>to</sup>;

1           Whereas, during his tenure as Bovina town board chairman, Butch also served  
2 as president of the Wisconsin Towns Association for several years; and

3           Whereas, Butch was first elected to the Wisconsin assembly in 1964, served  
4 continuously from the 1965 ~~through the~~ <sup>to</sup> 1981 sessions, and was appointed to  
5 numerous committees including the excise and fees committee and the highway  
6 committee; and

7           Whereas, during his tenure in the assembly, Mr. Conradt's concern was to  
8 provide the best service to his constituents including his support of any bill that was  
9 beneficial to his district; and

10           Whereas, after his tenure in the assembly, Butch was appointed to the serve on  
11 the state ~~Special Highway Project Commission~~ in 1987 by Governor Tommy G.
