Whereas, we acknowledge and honor the estimated 11,000,000 to 12,000,000 African men, women, and children who were forcibly embarked on European vessels for a life of slavery in the Western Hemisphere and the 9,000,000 to 10,000,000 enslaved African survivors of the Middle Passage to America; and

Whereas, throughout the struggle, African-Americans have maintained a rich, distinctive culture and have made major contributions to the American culture and the world; and

Whereas, through the contributions of such African-Americans as Harriet Tubman, Sojourner Truth, Fredrick Douglas, W.E.B. Du Bois, Booker T. Washington, Thurgood Marshall, Reverend Dr. Martin Luther King, Fannie Lou Hamer, Malik El Shabazz, Shirley Chisholm, and James Cameron, the founder of the first and only Black holocaust museum in the United States (located in Milwaukee), America's
