1     **Relating to:** the retirement of Cliff Miller.

2           Whereas, Cliff Miller has been a Capitol correspondent for the *Appleton*  
3     *Post-Crescent* since 1975; and

4           Whereas, his roots in the Fox Valley date back to 1957, when he graduated from  
5     Menasha High School; and

6           Whereas, Cliff attended the University of Wisconsin – Madison and graduated  
7     with a bachelor’s degree in journalism in 1962; and

8           Whereas, he started his career at the *Twin Cities News-Record* in April 1966,  
9     covering Neenah and Menasha; and

10          Whereas, from 1969 to 1973 Cliff began to cover the City of Appleton  
11     government beat for the *Post-Crescent*; and

12          Whereas, one of the highlights of his career was being awarded an American  
13     Political Science Association fellowship in 1973–74 to work and study inside  
14     Congress, obtaining assignments to the staffs of former Vice President and Senator  
15     Hubert H. Humphrey and former U.S. Representative Morris K. Udall; and
