1 **Relating to:** memorializing Congress to pass House Resolution 1717, to require
2 Department of Veterans Affairs pharmacies to dispense medications to
3 veterans for prescriptions written by private practitioners.

4 Whereas, our nation owes a great debt to the veterans of our armed forces; and

5 Whereas, many veterans are experiencing difficulty purchasing their
6 prescription drugs; and

7 Whereas, veterans without severe service-connected disabilities and whose
8 income is above the level that makes them eligible for free care may obtain needed
9 medications at Veterans Affairs facilities for the very reasonable cost of \$2 per
10 prescription per 30-day supply; and

11 Whereas, this program is only available to ^a veterans ^g who ^{has} received
12 ^a prescriptions ^a from Veterans Affairs physicians ^g after an outpatient visit; and
