"Section 96. Assembly rule 98b is created to read:

Assembly Rule 98b. **Campaign contributions.** (1) In this rule, "contribution," "legislative campaign committee," and "personal campaign committee" have the meanings given for the terms in section 11.01 of the statutes.

(2) A legislative leader may not schedule, hold, or attend, or solicit, make, or receive a contribution for or at; or authorize a legislative campaign committee to schedule, hold, or attend, or solicit, make, or receive a contribution for or at; and a member may not schedule, hold, or attend, or solicit, make, or receive a contribution for or at; or authorize the member's personal campaign committee to schedule, hold, or attend, or solicit, make, or receive a contribution for or at; a fund–raising social event or otherwise after January 1 of the odd–numbered year and before the

executive budget bill introduced under section 16.47 (1) of the statutes is passed by both houses.

- (3) Subsection (2) does not apply to a fund–raising social event of a legislative campaign committee held during the period between the first day authorized for filing nomination papers for any special election to the assembly and the date of the special election.
- (4) Subsection (2) does not apply to a fund–raising social event of a current member of the assembly or his or her personal campaign committee held during the period between the first day authorized for filing nomination papers for any office for which a current member of the assembly is a candidate and the date of the election for that office, if the event is held within the boundaries of the jurisdiction or district served by the office for which the current member of the assembly is a candidate.
- (5) Subsection (2) does not apply to a fund–raising social event of a current member of the assembly or his or her personal campaign committee held during the period between the first day authorized for filing nomination papers for any office, other than representative to the assembly, for which a current member of the assembly is a candidate and the date of the election for that other office.".
