2	1. Page 14, line 11: delete lines 11 to 24.
3	2. Page 15, line 1: delete lines 1 to 23 and substitute:
4	"SECTION 17m. Assembly rule 15 (title), (1) to (3), (4) (intro.), (b) and (c), (5) and
5	(6) are amended to read:
6	Assembly Rule 15 (title) Withdrawing a proposal or veto from
7	committee. (1) No <u>A</u> proposal <u>or veto</u> may <u>not</u> be withdrawn from any committee
8	until 21 calendar days have expired since the proposal <u>or veto</u> was referred to the
9	committee. After the 21-day period, proposals <u>a proposal or veto</u> may be withdrawn
10	either by motion or by petition, but:
11	(a) No <u>A</u> bill may <u>not</u> be withdrawn from a joint survey committee.

(b) No <u>A</u> bill requiring, but not having, an emergency statement for passage
 may <u>not</u> be withdrawn from the joint committee on finance or from the committee on
 rules.

4 (2) The motion to withdraw a proposal <u>or veto</u> from committee shall be <u>is</u> in
5 order only on the first day in any week on which the call of the roll is taken under
6 the first order of business. Such <u>The</u> motions shall be decided by <u>majority</u> vote <u>of a</u>
7 <u>majority of the members present and voting</u>.

8 (3) Once a motion to withdraw a proposal <u>or veto</u> from a committee which 9 requires a majority vote <u>of a majority of the members present and voting</u> fails, all 10 subsequent motions to withdraw that proposal <u>or veto</u> from the same committee shall 11 require a <u>vote of two-thirds majority of the members present and voting</u> for adoption 12 and shall be decided without debate.

13 (4) (intro.) A petition to withdraw a proposal <u>or veto</u> from committee requires
14 the personal signatures of a majority of the assembly's current membership.

(b) Each withdrawal petition signature shall be dated by the signer.
Withdrawal petitions may not be circulated prior to before the expiration of the
21-day period.

(c) Any withdrawal petition shall be filed with the chief clerk, who shall
immediately examine it for compliance with this rule. All questions concerning the
adequacy of a withdrawal petition shall be decided by the speaker.

(5) Immediately upon adoption of any <u>a</u> withdrawal motion or the chief clerk's
announcement of receipt of a proper withdrawal petition, the affected proposal shall
be <u>or veto is</u> taken from committee and placed in the committee on rules for calendar
scheduling, but, if the withdrawal was is from that committee, the affected proposal

shall be or veto is placed directly on the calendar for the 2nd legislative day
 thereafter.

(6) Whenever a bill is introduced in the assembly or senate under section 227.19
(5) (e) or 227.26 (2) (f) of the statutes, the bill shall be is considered reported without
recommendation and shall be is placed before the committee on rules if no a report
is not received from the standing committee within 30 days of after the date of
referral. This subsection does not apply if the bill is introduced within 30 days of
after the time at which no further proposals may not be introduced or offered in the
regular session under joint rule 83 (2).".

3. Page 17, line 7: delete lines 7 to 10 and substitute:

11 "(3) The report of the committee shall be reproduced in the journal. 12 Notwithstanding subs. (1) and (2), the chief clerk shall record in the journal that a 13 bill <u>or veto</u> is reported without recommendation whenever the bill <u>or veto</u> is 14 withdrawn from committee under rule 15 (6) prior to before the committee's vote on 15 the bill <u>or veto</u>.".

4. Page 32, line 10: after "proposal" insert "or veto".

17 5. Page 33, line 21: after "<u>officer</u>" insert "<u>within 7 working days after the</u>
18 <u>receipt.</u>".

6. Page 48, line 16: after that line insert:

20 **"SECTION 75m.** Assembly rule 74 (3) is amended to read:

ASSEMBLY RULE 74 (3) A motion to table may not be applied to procedural motions, except that a motion to withdraw a proposal <u>or veto</u> from committee may be tabled if the motion to withdraw does not involve a suspension of the rules.".
