2 1. Page 40, line 6: after that line insert:

3 "SECTION 57m. Assembly rule 56 (1) is amended to read:

4 Assembly Rule 56 (1) Any member who desires to speak in debate or submit
5 any matter to the assembly shall rise in his or her assigned place and respectfully
6 address the presiding officer. Upon being recognized, the member shall confine his
7 or her remarks to the question before the assembly and shall avoid personalities. A
8 member may not question the motives of another member. A member may be
9 recognized or addressed only by the number of the member's district."
