

2001 ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 48

January 28, 2002 – Introduced by Representatives MUSSER and RYBA. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1 **Relating to:** commemorating the United States Military Academy at West Point on
2 its bicentennial anniversary.

3 Whereas, the United States Military Academy at West Point was established
4 by an 1802 Act of Congress and is celebrating its 200th anniversary on March 16,
5 2002; and

6 Whereas, the United States Military Academy at West Point was the first
7 national education institution in the country and the mission of the United States
8 Military Academy at West Point continues to be to educate, train, and inspire a corps
9 of cadets; and

10 Whereas, the United States Military Academy at West Point has graduated
11 thousands of Americans as commissioned officers who have led the U.S. Army in
12 winning in war and preserving peace; and

13 Whereas, the United States Military Academy at West Point trains cadets
14 committed to the values reflective of the academy's motto — Duty, Honor, Country
15 — to serve a selfless lifetime to the nation; and
