This assembly resolution prohibits the payment of legal fees by the assembly for representatives to the assembly, assembly employees, and assembly committees before they have been approved by the state auditor, effective with fees paid after adoption of this resolution.

Resolved by the assembly, That legal fees of representatives to the assembly, assembly employees, and assembly committees may not be paid by the assembly before they have been approved by the state auditor under standards established and publicized by the state auditor, effective with fees paid after adoption of this resolution.
