

2001 ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 52

1 **Relating to:** requesting the U.S. Congress not to attempt to repeal or rescind any
2 of the tax relief legislation passed by the U.S. Congress in May 2001.

3 Whereas, the Economic Growth and Tax Relief Reconciliation Act of 2001 (H.R.
4 1836) was passed with bipartisan support; and

5 Whereas, the bill granted much-needed tax relief for all working families in
6 Wisconsin; and

7 Whereas, some members of the U.S. Congress are calling for the repeal or delay
8 of parts of the tax relief bill, which would in effect raise taxes on Wisconsin's families;
9 now, therefore, be it

10 *Resolved by the assembly, That* the members of the Wisconsin assembly
11 respectfully request the U.S. Congress to leave the tax cuts in the Economic Growth
12 and Tax Relief Reconciliation Act of 2001 (H.R. 1836) intact, to allow the
13 implementation or acceleration of the tax relief therein, and to add further tax relief
14 measures if needed; and, be it further
