**Resolved by the assembly, That** the members of the Wisconsin assembly respectfully request the U.S. Congress to leave the tax cuts in the Economic Growth and Tax Relief Reconciliation Act of 2001 (H.R. 1836) intact, to allow the implementation or acceleration of the tax relief therein, and to add further tax relief measures if needed; and, be it further
