2 1. Page 1, line 1: delete "modernization" and substitute "maintaining and
3 rehabilitating waterways and aquatic ecosystems". *and*

4 2. Page ³4, line ¹⁷1: delete "is the most environmentally friendly form of
5 transporting goods and commodities, creating" and substitute "creates". ✓

6 3. Page 3, line ³3: after that line insert:

7 "Whereas, our waterway transportation infrastructure shares the public
8 waters with the natural environment; and

9 Whereas, the natural environment provides public benefits such as recreation,
10 tourism, domestic and industrial water supply, and scientific and educational
11 opportunities that also are important elements to Wisconsin's economy; and ✓

12 Whereas, the upper Mississippi River ecological system is a natural resource
13 of statewide, regional, national, and international importance due to its status as one

1 of the largest floodplain areas in the world, its importance as a migratory corridor
2 for 40 percent of all North American waterfowl, and the sanctuary it provides to more
3 than 200 species of plants and animals, including threatened, endangered, or rare
4 species; and".

5 plain 4. Page 3, line 1: after that line insert:

6 **Resolved, That** the legislature recognizes the critical habitat restoration and
7 rehabilitation needs of the upper Mississippi River's ecological resources; ^{and,} be it
8 further".

9 5. Page 7, line 4: delete "to construct 1,200-foot lock on the upper Mississippi
10 and Illinois river system" and substitute "funding" to support sustainable
11 environmental programs on the upper Mississippi River system". Plain
