Rep. Freese would like to draft three separate amendments to the CWD bill (LRB-5097/1).

1) The State would reimburse landowners in the eradication zone \$50 for every deer killed on their property. The owner would only be reimbursed with each and every tag filled out and submitted to the DNR. RNK —

2) The use of any firearm by anyone from airplanes and helicopters for directly killing deer would be prohibited. Airplanes and helicopters could be used for surveillance purposes. RNK —

3) The State would be required to build an incinerator for the purpose of disposing of the deer carcasses. Robin, I'm not sure how you would draft this one. The incinerator would be operated by the DNR, but who authorizes the construction? The Building Commission? The incinerator would have to be completed by January 1, 2003. RCT —

12 the incinerator under s. 23.199. For the purposes of s. 23.0917, moneys expended

2 as moneys obligated under the subprogram for[✓] property development and local
3 assistance.

4 **SECTION 4n.** 23.199[✓] of the statutes is created to read:

5 **23.199 Disposal of carcasses.** The department shall construct and operate
6 an incinerator for the disposal of the carcasses of animals killed to manage chronic
7 wasting disease. The department shall construct the incinerator on land that is
8 owned by this state on the effective date of this section[✓] [revisor inserts date]. The
9 department shall begin operation of the incinerator by January 1, 2003, or as soon
10 thereafter as possible.[✓]

Then on page 1 line 11-12 there is the reference to construction cost limits. Rep. Freese wants to include costs for operating the incinerator as well and I have no idea how much it would cost to operate an incinerator, but does setting the limit at \$250,000 annually sound reasonable?
