2	Whereas, Timothy Dolan was named the 10th Archbishop of Milwaukee by
3	Pope John Paul II on June 25, 2002; and
4	Whereas, the Archdiocese of Milwaukee was established in 1843 and includes
5	10 counties of southeastern Wisconsin and over 600,000 Catholics; and
6	Whereas, Archbishop Dolan has served as a parish priest, as secretary to the
7	Apostolic Nunciature in Washington, D.C., as rector of the Pontifical North
8	American College in Rome, and most recently as Auxiliary Bishop of St. Louis,
9	Missouri; and
10	Whereas, as Archbishop of Milwaukee, he will be the highest ranking and most
11	visible leader of the Catholic church in Wisconsin; and
12	Whereas, he has demonstrated throughout his career characteristics that will
13	serve him well in that role: strength, courage, warmth, and humility; now, therefore,
14	be it

1	Resolved by the assembly, That the Wisconsin assembly welcomes
2	Archbishop Dolan to Wisconsin; and, be it further
3	Resolved, That the assembly chief clerk shall provide a copy of this resolution
4	to Archbishop Dolan.
