This is a sum sufficient appropriation, so we cannot lapse money from it. Do you want the transfer to the environmental fund to be less than what the appropriation language and s. 85.037 would provide? If so, we can come up with some language to reduce it for the second fiscal year. The transfer for the first fiscal year has, by law, already occurred. If the desire is to, in effect, retroactively reduce that transfer, that can be done by transferring money from the environmental fund back to the general fund.

9 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of agriculture, trade and  
10 consumer protection under section 20.115 (7) (qd) of the statutes, as affected by the  
11 acts of 2001, the dollar amount is decreased by \$123,100 for fiscal year 2001–02 and  
12 the dollar amount is decreased by \$246,200 for fiscal year 2002–03 to reduce funding  
13 for the purpose for which the appropriation is made.

14           **SECTION 9237. Appropriation changes; natural resources.**

15           (1) **NONPOINT SOURCE RESEARCH AND EVALUATION, ENVIRONMENTAL FUND.** In the  
16 schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the  
17 department of natural resources under section 20.370 (3) (mt) of the statutes, as  
18 affected by the acts of 2001, the dollar amount is decreased by \$9,800 for fiscal year  
19 2001–02 and the dollar amount is decreased by \$19,500 for fiscal year 2002–03 to  
20 decrease funding for the purpose for which the appropriation is made.

1           (2) TRADING WATER POLLUTION CREDITS, ENVIRONMENTAL FUND. In the schedule  
2 under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of  
3 natural resources under section 20.370 (4) (as) of the statutes, as affected by the acts  
4 of 2001, the dollar amount is decreased by \$1,300 for fiscal year 2001–02 and the  
5 dollar amount is decreased by \$2,500 for fiscal year 2002–03 to decrease funding for  
6 the purpose for which the appropriation is made.

7           (3) NONPOINT SOURCE CONTRACTS, ENVIRONMENTAL FUND. In the schedule under

23 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of natural  
24 resources under section 20.370 (6) (au) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 2001,  
25 the dollar amount is decreased by \$3,800 for fiscal year 2001–02 and the dollar

1 amount is decreased by \$7,600 for fiscal year 2002-03 to decrease funding for the  
2 purpose for which the appropriation is made.

3 (7) URBAN NONPOINT SOURCE AND MUNICIPAL FLOOD CONTROL AIDS, ENVIRONMENTAL

8 to decrease funding for the purpose for which the appropriation is made.

9 (8) ADMINISTRATION AND TECHNOLOGY, ENVIRONMENTAL FUND. In the schedule  
10 under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of  
11 natural resources under section 20.370 (8) (mv) of the statutes, as affected by the acts  
12 of 2001, the dollar amount is decreased by \$18,200 for fiscal year 2001-02 and the  
13 dollar amount is decreased by \$36,300 for fiscal year 2002-03 to decrease funding  
14 for the purpose for which the appropriation is made.

15 (9) CUSTOMER ASSISTANCE, ENVIRONMENTAL FUND. In the schedule under section  
16 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of natural  
17 resources under section 20.370 (9) (mv) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 2001,  
18 the dollar amount is decreased by \$2,000 for fiscal year 2001-02 and the dollar  
19 amount is decreased by \$4,000 for fiscal year 2002-03 to decrease funding for the  
20 purpose for which the appropriation is made.

21 (10) ENVIRONMENTAL FUND TRANSFER. There is transferred from the  
22 environmental fund to the general fund \$385,000 in fiscal year 2001-02.
