Please draft the following:

1. Decrease the appropriation under s. 20.285(1)(a), by \$10 million for FY2001-2002 and \$40 million for FY2002-2003.
2. Prohibit the Board of Regents from increasing total\* tuition and fees by more than 10% in FY 2002-2003 without first receiving approval from the Joint Committee on Finance. Sunset provision (or include as non-stat language) on June 30, 2003.  
*\*Note - By total, the intent is to limit the cumulative total increase to 10%. In allocating tuition increases, the Board can choose to increase tuition for an individual campus or category (e.g., the law school) by more than 10% as long as the cumulative total for the System does not exceed 10%.*

Please amend 4491-2 to require the Board of Regents to obtain Department of Administration approval before the request is submitted to the Joint Finance Committee. While I suspect there may be wording problems with this, I offer the suggested language below.

The intent is to require both parties to approve a resident undergraduate tuition increase greater than 10%. If this creates legal or precedent-setting problems because, under 13.10, JCF does not need DOA approval to approve increased spending authority by an agency, could we use the 16.515 process where the DOA secretary makes the actual request to JCF?

My preference is to do something under 13.10 if possible. Give me a call (6-1037) if you need further clarification. As always, thanks much.

4 student in the 2002-03 academic year compared to the average academic fees  
5 charged an undergraduate student in the 2001-02 academic year by more than 10%  
6 unless the board obtains the approval of the joint committee on finance under section  
7 13.10 of the statutes and the approval of the secretary of administration. The board  
8 of regents shall determine average academic fees under this subsection on a  
9 full-time equivalent basis. The board may not increase differential tuition under  
10 section 36.27 (1) (am) 6. of the statutes for the 2002-03 academic year to offset  
11 decreases in the appropriations under section 20.285 (1) (a) and (3) (a) of the statutes.
