The intent of this request is to create a state-level grant writing office to identify and pursue public and private sources of available grants. The office will be based at Commerce as part of the Secretary's office and will serve as a clearinghouse for federal grants and private sources of funding. It will offer training and assistance in pursuing grants to governmental agencies, non-profit organizations and schools. It will also serve as a clearinghouse for government contracts for private businesses.

The office will be staffed by a grants management specialist-advanced position, which will be funded by increasing appropriation s. 20.143(4)(a) by 1.0 FTE unclassified position, \$26,000 GPR for FY02 and \$56,300 GPR for FY03. An additional unclassified position will need to be added to Commerce's position count with the position's salary to be set by the appointing authority (s. 20.923(6)).
