Notwithstanding section 14.065 of the statutes, the secretary of administration shall allocate all oil overcharge restitution funds and all accruing interest earnings on those funds under section 20.505 (1) (md) of the statutes that are not approved for expenditure on the effective date of this subsection, for reduction of lead paint hazards in dwellings that is done to allow for and in conjunction with energy conservation activities in rental properties owned by persons who seek a certificate of lead-free status, as defined in section 254.11 (4g) of the statutes, as created by this act, or a certificate of lead-safe status, as defined in section 254.11 (4h) of the statutes, as created by this act. In awarding moneys under this subsection, the department of administration shall give priority to projects that emphasize comprehensive lead removal plans for rental properties.
