Draft Title: MA Base Re-Estimate

Agency Affected: Department of Health and Family Services (435)

Purpose: The purpose of this draft would be to increase the aids appropriation for the Medical Assistance program by \$30,000,000 GPR in the 2001-02 fiscal year and by \$30,000,000 GPR in the 2002-03 fiscal year. This increase is to account for a re-estimate of the program's cost.

Under current federal and state law, medical assistance (MA) is a federal-state, jointly funded program that provides reimbursement for health care services provided to MA recipients who have few assets and low income.

Under current state law, the state portion of funding for MA program benefits is from general purpose revenues and from the MA trust fund.

This bill increases the general purpose revenues funding for MA program benefits by \$30,000,000 in each of fiscal years 2001-02 and 2002-03.
