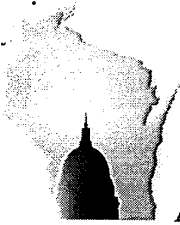

Please draft language for the budget adjustment bill related to a new position of Homeland Security Coordinator. The coordinator will be appointed by the Governor and will maintain a statewide coordinating function for all of the state's security needs. However, we are not requesting the creation of a new position. Instead, please draft language to give the DOA Secretary the authority to reallocate one of the unclassified positions listed in chapter 20 (s.20.923) to fill this position.

He wants to give DOA the authority to take a position from an executive agency and transfer that position to the governor's office. He says this draft will be part of a larger request coming from the governor regarding security.

I am writing to provide you more information about the homeland security advisor position. We do want the language included in the budget adjustment bill, and it should be consolidated with draft #4572 submitted by Sue Jablonsky.

The position will be appointed by the Governor and will be located in the Governor's Office. The bill needs to give the DOA Secretary the authority to redeploy an existing unclassified position from anywhere in the executive branch to serve in this capacity.

SECTION 9129. Nonstatutory provisions; governor?

(1) POSITION TRANSFER. (a) In this subsection, "executive branch agency" has the meaning given in section 16.70 (4) of the statutes.

(b) Notwithstanding section 16.505 (1) of the statutes, unless otherwise required by state or federal law, the governor may, prior to January 1, 2003, transfer to the office of the governor 1.0 FTE position authorized for any executive branch agency that is vacant on the date of the transfer and that was occupied by an employee in the unclassified service immediately prior to the date that the position was vacated for the purpose of filling the domestic security coordinator position authorized under section 14.21 of the statutes, as created by this act.
