Move to provide that no state agency subject to any program revenue or segregated revenue lapses or transfers to the general fund under the bill may increase any fees, chargebacks or assessments for any appropriation associated with those lapses and transfers without first receiving the approval of the Joint Committee on Finance under a 14-day passive review process.

Note:

This prohibition is similar to language adopted by the Committee at its November 5, 2001, and its December 18, 2001, meetings under s. 13.10 approving various agency PR and SEG lapses and transfers to the general fund.
