OTHER STATE GOVERNMENT

Under current law, the statutes provide that a fiscal estimate must be prepared for any bill making an appropriation and any bill increasing or decreasing existing appropriations or state or general local government fiscal liability or revenues. This bill requires that an estimate of the economic impact on a private person or a political subdivision of this state must also be prepared.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- 2 Section 1. 13.093 (2) (a) and (b) of the statutes are amended to read:
- 3 13.093 (2) (a) Any bill making an appropriation and any bill increasing or
- 4 decreasing existing appropriations or state or general local government fiscal

liability or revenues or having an economic impact on a private person or a political subdivision of this state shall, before any vote is taken thereon by either house of the legislature if the bill is not referred to a standing committee, or before any public hearing is held before any standing committee or, if no public hearing is held, before any vote is taken by the committee, incorporate a reliable estimate of the anticipated change in appropriation authority or state or general local government fiscal liability or revenues and a reliable estimate of the anticipated economic impact on a private person or a political subdivision of this state under the bill, including to the extent possible a projection of such changes in future biennia. For purposes of this paragraph, a bill increasing or decreasing the liability or revenues of the unemployment reserve fund is considered to increase or decrease state fiscal liability or revenues. Except as otherwise provided by joint rules of the legislature, such estimates shall be made by the department or agency administering the appropriation or fund or collecting the revenue or administering the law creating the economic impact. The joint survey committee on retirement systems shall prepare the fiscal estimate with respect to the provisions of any bill referred to it which create or modify any system for, or make any provision for, the retirement of or payment of pensions to public officers or employees. When a fiscal estimate or economic impact estimate is prepared after the bill has been introduced, it shall be printed and distributed as are amendments.

(b) Executive budget bills introduced under s. 16.47 (1) are exempt from the fiscal estimate requirement under par. (a) but shall, if they contain a provision affecting a public retirement fund or providing a tax exemption, be analyzed as to those provisions by the respective joint survey committee. If such a bill contains a provision providing a tax exemption, the bill shall be simultaneously referred to the

- joint survey committee on tax exemptions and the joint committee on finance. The report of the joint survey committee on tax exemptions shall be prepared within 60 days of introduction for bills introduced under s. 16.47 (1).
