Statement of Intent

The cause of high water on the lakes has been determined to be excessive groundwater recharge. Indications are that the water will continue to rise, resulting in sustained adverse affects on lake levels, and the surrounding ecosystems; as well as public and private property in the area. Pumping water from Fish/Mud Lake to the Wisconsin River and maintaining a reasonable water level lower than the current level would provide numerous public interest benefits for each of the three lakes and their surrounding areas. Lower lake levels and improved water quality would help improve recreational opportunities, contribute to the return of the lakes to normal fish and aquatic vegetation environments, as well as restore lost wildlife habitat and shoreline and non-point buffer zones. In addition to contributing to improved recreational opportunities, lower lake levels would also alleviate the need for ongoing repair to town roads eroded by high water, stop the continuous damage to homes and property located along the lakes, and allow residential property to remain on Town tax rolls.

Move to require DNR to provide up to \$200,000 of matching funds from the Recreational Boating Projects Program (DNR - Waterways) in 2003 for lake level improvements of Fish, Crystal and Mud Lakes in NW Dane County (found in the 47th Assembly District and the 16th Senate District) to be used for the installation of a water pumping and drainpipe system from Fish/Mud Lakes to the Wisconsin River. A similar amendment was approved by Caucus and by the Budget Conference Committee in 2001, but was vetoed by the Governor. Because this amendment directs funds from a different DNR program and carries the 'matching' stipulation, the Governor's office has agreed to give additional consideration to this proposal if it is adopted.
