Statement of Intent

While the SAGE program is very popular among many school districts, for others it is cost-prohibitive. Many school districts must augment the SAGE money they receive from the state with local money. Allowing schools to participate in fewer years of the program would relieve the strain on a school district's budget at the same time allowing SAGE to serve the students who are the most in need.

Summary

Under current law, schools that participate in the SAGE program must participate in all four years of the program - Kindergarten through 3rd grade. This amendment would allow participating schools to enter into contracts for less than the full four years. Under this amendment, schools could participate in SAGE for 1 or more grades, between Kindergarten and 3rd grade. This would allow for more local flexibility to use the program in a way that best serves their students.

Discussion

This amendment could save the state money because some schools may choose to only participate in only two years of the program, for example, Kindergarten and Grade 1. It is difficult to determine what the cost savings would be.

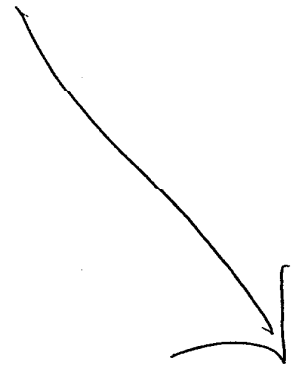
