Hi Pam,

The ARC passed two amendments on Saturday that need to be drafted for the ARC budget amendment.

One is AB 642, as passed by the Assembly, related to WHEFA financing for private K-12 schools. 3313

The other is a HIRSP amendment, which would incorporate provisions of AB 348, as passed by the Assembly, plus the following:

1. Require DHFS to have a new contract in place no later than July 1, 2003 for the HIRSP plan administrator that has been awarded based on a competitive bidding selection process identified in AB 348.
2. The HIRSP admin appropriation [s. 20.435 (4)(u)] should be reduced by \$609,600 in 2001-02 and \$451,300 in 2002-03.
3. Prohibit DHFS from awarding the plan administrator contract to a vendor that does not have information systems in place that are compliant with the final standards adopted under the administrative simplification provisions in HIPAA.

1 **AN ACT to amend** 231.01 (4m) of the statutes; **relating to:** authorizing the
2 Wisconsin Health and Educational Facilities Authority to issue bonds to
3 finance a project undertaken for a facility used for education by a private,
4 tax-exempt institution.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the Wisconsin Health and Educational Facilities Authority (WHEFA) may issue bonds to finance certain projects undertaken for educational facilities. Projects that may be financed include, among others, the construction, remodeling, furnishing, or equipping of an educational facility or related structure. An educational facility is defined as a regionally accredited, private, nonprofit postsecondary educational institution. This bill redefines an educational facility as a facility used for education by a regionally accredited, private, nonprofit institution so that the education-related projects for which WHEFA may issue bonds are not limited to facilities and related structures for postsecondary education purposes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
