Eliminate Legislative Hotline

Provide for the end of the legislative hotline, effective July 1, 2002. Delete 2.0 authorized positions that staff the hotline and reduce the Assembly and Senate general program operations appropriations by \$30,000 GPR each in 2002-03. Specify that the central legislative hotline number no longer be included on the state maps published by the Department of Transportation.

[Change to Joint Finance: -\$60,000 GPR]

Reduce 20,765 (1)(a) and (1)(b) as follows:

(1)(a)	<u>02-03</u>
	-30,000
(1)(b)	-30,000

Also delete 1.0 authorized FTE position for each.

6 organization, and the senate committee on organization may not maintain a toll-free
7 telephone service for the use of members of the public to contact members of the
8 legislature or for the use of members of the legislature to contact members of the
9 public.
