Require DOT to design the reconstruction of the Marquette Interchange and I-94 in Milwaukee and Waukesha Counties to allow for expansion of capacity for vehicular traffic on those highways to meet the projected vehicular traffic capacity needs, as determined by the Department, for 30 years following the completion of the reconstruction of those highways. (This was also in the budget bill.)
- 10. Specify that, in administering the local roads for job preservation program, DOT may specify the type of pavement to be used in any project under the program to ensure that alternatives are chosen that lead to the greatest long-term cost effectiveness. (or something like that)

AN ACT to create 84.014 (5) of the statutes; relating to: vehicular traffic capacity expansion and reconstruction of the Marquette interchange and I 94 in

Milwaukee and Waukesha counties.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law provides funding for reconstruction of the Marquette interchange, lying at or near the junction of I 94, I 43, and I 794, in Milwaukee County by the department of transportation (DOT).

This bill requires DOT to design reconstruction of the Marquette interchange and I 94 in Milwaukee and Waukesha counties to allow for vehicular traffic capacity expansion on the Marquette interchange and I 94 in these counties to meet projected vehicular traffic capacity needs for the 30–year period beginning after reconstruction is completed.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in separte and assembly; do enact as follows:

SECTION 84.014 (5) of the statutes is created to read:
