Summary No taxpayer tuition subsidies after 165 credits (5.5 years full-time undergraduate studies). 3,308 students currently have accumulated more than 165 credits. Taxpayers are responsible for 60% of those tuition costs under current law with no limits on credits. Students could still attend universities beyond 165 but would incur 100% of costs. Taxpayers 0%. Presently, there is no credit restrictions on students.

Essential Impact generates \$6.7 million in savings (source: UW System)
