The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

#. Page 8, line 8: after that line insert:

1. SECTION 1. 14.21 of the statutes is created to read:

2. **14.21 Renew Wisconsin.** (1) In this section:

3. (a) "Committee" means a committee appointed under sub. (2).

4. (b) "State agency" means an office, department, independent agency,
5. institution of higher education, association, society, or other body in the executive
6. branch of state government created or authorized to be created by the constitution
7. or any law and that is entitled to expend moneys appropriated by law, but not
8. including an authority created in ch. 231, 233, or 234.

9. (2) The governor shall establish a program, entitled "Renew Wisconsin," under
10. which the governor will appoint a committee for each state agency to conduct periodic
11. performance evaluations of the operations of each state agency. In appointing
12. members to the various committees, the governor shall seek to appoint to each
13. committee both state and local government public officials and employees and
14. individuals who are not state and local government public officials and employees.

15. (3) Each committee shall review the performance of the state agency assigned
16. to the committee and shall identify ways in which the state agency can improve its
17. responsiveness to the residents of this state and ways in which the state agency can
18. reduce the costs of performing its duties.

19. (4) Each committee shall review the statutes and rules that affect the operation
20. of the state agency assigned to the committee for review and shall do all of the

14 and recommendations to the governor and the chief clerk of each house of the
15 legislature, for distribution to the legislature under s. 13.172 (2).)
