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

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT ,

TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,

TO ASSEMBLY BILL 1

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 1. Page 348, line <sup>9</sup>~~24~~: after that line insert:

3 “(6<sup>e</sup>) LAPSES FROM CERTAIN APPROPRIATIONS FROM WHICH MEMBERSHIP DUES IN  
4 STATE AND NATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS ARE PAID.

5 (a) In this subsection:

6 1. “Secretary” means the secretary of administration.

7 2. “State agency” has the meaning given in section 20.001 (1) of the statutes.

8 (b) The secretary shall determine for each state agency the amount expended  
9 by the state agency for membership dues for any national, state, or local organization

1 in the 2000–01 fiscal year that was funded from general purpose revenue and the  
2 appropriation from which the dues were paid.

3 (c) From each sum certain appropriation of general purpose revenue identified  
4 in paragraph (b), the secretary of administration shall lapse to the general fund in  
5 the 2002–03 fiscal year an amount that equals 20% of the amount specified in  
6 paragraph (b) for that appropriation. After the secretary makes the lapse, each of  
7 the sum certain appropriations is decreased by the amount of the lapse.

8 (d) For each sum sufficient appropriation of general purpose revenue identified  
9 in paragraph (b), the expenditure estimate for the appropriation during the 2002–03  
10 fiscal year is reestimated to subtract an amount that equals 20% of the amount  
11 specified in paragraph (b) for that appropriation.”
