Bob,

This is the text of the request we received from the Racine County Clerk of Circuit Courts: Counties are required to print and stock all state-mandated forms used in the courts and other departments. Many of the forms seem to be updated annually, which means that unused forms are discarded and new forms must be printed and distributed. Some forms can be printed on regular paper, but many required multi-part carbonless stock that we must print. Our suggestions is to make all forms printable on regular paper and e-mailed to us, so we can run them off as needed, with no stocking of special papers or special printing.

- I spoke with the lady and she told me that the excessive cost occurs when they spend money to print off the forms (evictions, restraining orders, small claims court forms etc.)
- She said if the forms are available through records management, then the counties are required to use them.
- She also said much of the general public doesn't have access to websites where the forms are available so the court system then must provide them.
