- Restrictions for Expenditures for Legal and Consulting Fees for Redistricting: No more than \$260,000 may be expended for legal and consulting services per House. (see LRBb1371/1)

KAC

- Delete executive assistant positions in all GPR financed agencies and consequently adjust the appropriation schedule to reflect savings of \$1,134,900. This would include DADCP, DPI, WI Technical College System, DOC, DHFS, DOJ, Military Affairs, DOA, Employment Relations and DOR.

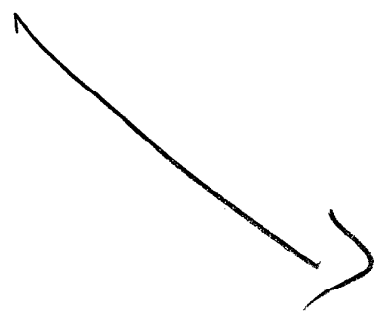
