**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT ,**  
**TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,**  
**TO ASSEMBLY BILL 1**

1           At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2           **1.** Page 5, line 4: after that line insert:

3           “**SECTION 7m.** 13.205 of the statutes is created to read:

4           **13.205 Legislative hotline prohibited.** (1) Except as provided in sub. (2),  
5           the joint committee on legislative organization, the assembly committee on  
6           organization, and the senate committee on organization may not maintain a toll-free  
7           telephone service for the use of members of the public to contact members of the  
8           legislature or for the use of members of the legislature to contact members of the  
9           public.

1           (2) An organization committee under sub. (1) may maintain or allow the  
2 maintenance of one toll-free telephone service per member of the legislature for the  
3 use of members of the public to contact the member of the legislature. The senate  
4 committee on organization and the assembly committee on organization shall  
5 publish the number of the toll-free telephone service of each member of its house.”.

6           **2.** Page 153, line 25: after that line insert:

7           “**SECTION 257m.** 84.02 (5) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

8           84.02 (5) (a) As often as it deems necessary, the department shall publish  
9 highway service maps showing the state trunk highway system and such other main  
10 highways and other features as may seem desirable. Such highway service maps  
11 shall be sold by the department at a price to be fixed by it, which shall be not less than  
12 cost. The department may permit the use of the base plates for other maps and  
13 publications in consideration of a fair fee for such use. The department shall make  
14 and publish or duplicate such highway service maps as are required for its use, and  
15 shall publish folded highway maps of Wisconsin for free distribution to the public.  
16 The department shall ensure that the folded highway maps bear information  
17 regarding the requirements of s. 347.48 (4) and do not bear information regarding  
18 toll-free telephone service under s. 13.205.”.

19           **3.** Page 359, line 1: after that line insert:

20           “(1z) LEGISLATIVE HOTLINE.

21           (a) The authorized FTE positions for the assembly, funded from the  
22 appropriation under section 20.765 (1) (a) of the statutes, are decreased by 1.0 GPR  
23 position on July 1, 2002, for the purpose of eliminating the legislative hotline.

1 (b) The authorized FTE positions for the senate, funded from the appropriation  
2 under section 20.765 (1) (b) of the statutes, are decreased by 1.0 GPR position on July  
3 1, 2002, for the purpose of eliminating the legislative hotline.”.

4 **4.** Page 432, line 17: increase the dollar amount of the decrease for fiscal year  
5 2002–03 by \$30,000 for the purpose of eliminating the legislative hotline.

6 **5.** Page 432, line 18: increase the dollar amount of the decrease for fiscal year  
7 2002–03 by \$30,000 for the purpose of eliminating the legislative hotline.

8 **6.** Page 447, line 2: after that line insert:

9 “(1z) LEGISLATIVE HOTLINE. The treatment of sections 13.205 and 84.02 (5) (a)  
10 of the statutes takes effect on July 1, 2002.”.
