5 13.08 (2) ~~All members~~ Each member of the legislature shall be entitled to an
6 allowance for transportation expenses the member directly incurred in going to and
7 returning from the state capitol once every week during any legislative session, at
8 the same rate per mile for each mile traveled in going to and returning from the state
9 capitol on the most usual route as is provided for transportation for state officers and
10 employees under s. 20.916. A member may not claim an allowance for expenses
11 directly incurred by any other person. Such allowances shall be paid monthly upon

1 presentation to the department of administration of a verified written statement
2 containing such information as the department requires.

3 **SECTION 6.** 13.123 (1) (a) 1. of the statutes, as affected by 2001 Wisconsin Act
4 16, is amended to read:

5 13.123 (1) (a) 1. Any member of the legislature who has signified, by affidavit
6 filed with the department of administration, the necessity of establishing a
7 temporary residence at the state capital for the period of any regular or special
8 legislative session shall be entitled to an allowance for expenses incurred for food and
9 lodging for each day that he or she is in Madison on legislative business, but not
10 including any Saturday or Sunday unless the legislator is in actual attendance on
11 such day at a session of the legislature or a meeting of a standing committee of which
12 the legislator is a member. The amount of the allowance for each biennial session
13 shall be 90% of the per diem rate for travel for federal government business within
14 the city of Madison, as established by the federal general services administration.

15 A member who spends less than 4 hours in Madison on a Tuesday, Wednesday, or
16 Thursday may not claim an allowance for that day. A member may not use a different

17 certification system as employees of the legislature. A member who does not use a
18 hotel or apartment in Madison may only claim the allowance rate under subd. 2.

19 Members shall submit annual proof to the chief clerk for each day ^{that} they claim an
20 allowance. For the purpose of determining the amount of the allowance, the

21 secretary of employment relations shall certify to the chief clerk of each house the
22 federal per diem rate in effect on December 1, or the first business day thereafter if

23 December 1 is not a business day, in each even-numbered year. Each legislator shall
24 file an affidavit with the chief clerk of his or her house certifying the specific dollar
